Results from 2019...

- **KS4:** Our GCSE Progress 8 score of +0.12 places us in the **top third of schools nationally**.
- **KS4:** Progress score places us as the top school on the Isle of Wight and in the top quarter of all schools in the Hampshire and IoW region.
- **KS4:** All our core subject departments are in top third of schools nationally, and our Maths progress score of +0.33 places us in the **top sixth, nationally**.
- **KS5:** Average grade of C and point score of 31.59 places us in **top third of schools and colleges nationally**.
- **KS5:** Percentage of students achieving A-level AAB or higher in at least two facilitating subjects (commonly needed for entry to leading universities) was **27%**, placing us top of all schools and colleges in the Hampshire and IoW region, and in the **top 6% nationally**.
